Few important things about the vratham

- Any body can perform this vratham; any time there is no restriction of age, gender or caste to perform it. There is no need to fast on the day of the vratham. It is good to read this book on Ekadashi or Pournami or on the days of nakshatras Swathi, Makha and Purvabhadra. You can read it at your puja mandir in the morning. After reading it is good to offer 2 bananas as prasadam.
- Anybody with health problems or other problems, if they read this book for 3 continuous days in any temple their problems will be resolved.
- Before performing this vratham, do pray to Lord Ganesha in your mind then pray to the navagrahas. Then say your name, your family member's names and your gothram and then start the vratham. Then chant the 108 names of Shri Hanuman. Then perform Adhanga puja of Shri Hanuman. Then read the 5 of this vratham.
- If you read this vratham on a Saturday in a temple you will get success in exams before competitive exams you will get great success in those exams. .
- There is no rule that the couple should do this vratham together. The husband and wife can do the vratham according to their convenience and sometimes when possible they can do it together too.
- Unfortunately if a person lost his/her spouse they can do this vratham. They will get mental piece as a result of the vratham.
- If the priest reads these stories every Saturday in the temple, the temple will become very powerful and famous; all the devotees coming there will get Lord Hanumans grace.
- If you read and explain this to the devotees in a Hanuman temple, you get a lot of merit that will last for millions of lives.
- Those people who don't have kids, if they read the ashtotram and stories on Saturday they will get good kids. Similarly a girl or boy who is unmarried and seeking to get married, reads the ashtotram and stories in a temple for 3 days, they will get a good spouse soon.
- If your kids living far away cannot read, you can read for them to have kids, get married or get a good job. There will be good results.
- When possible it gives good results to call the priest and get this vratham done keeping a Kalasha and praying to Navagrahas and ashtadikpalakas.
- In this way any body can read this book according to their convenience and get good results.

In olden days in Andhra Pradesh there was a village called Dharmapuram. In that village there was a business man called Shubbi shetty. He started small businesses and luckily became very wealthy. He grew his businesses a lot. Although he looked like he has a lot of devotion towards god, he was very miserly. He would not take care of his servants well. If he had to donate 100 rupees to a temple. Till he earned 10 times that amount he would not give even a paisa in charity. In that village there was a great Anjeneya temple. Shubbi Shetty went to the temple every month. He would give 4 paisa to get archana done and get lots of prasadam so the whole family can have dinner. That day was Saturday, they were doing special pujas for Lord Hanuman. Lots of bhakthas were coming and having darshan. Shubbi Shetty came too. Like everytime he gave 4 paisa for archana and asked for a big packet of prasadam. He started going home on his bullock cart. After going some distance, the Zamindar from that village was coming in a bullock cart. Shubbhi Shetty got down did namaskaram and asked him how he was doing. The Zamindar said that he got a message from the Savakar at Ramapuram which is 40 miles from here. He needs 100 Kgs of Toor Dal by next week. I wanted to come to you Shubbhi Setty and ask if you can supply 100 kgs toor dal. Shubbhi Shetty was very happy, he could not say a word. "That is a great sale" he thought. "I can make a lot of profit. "He told the Zamindar I will surely send it.

Shubbhi Shetty went back to his bullock cart but he was not able to contain his happiness. "100 Kgs, Lots of Profit" He kept telling himself. He reached home. Thinking about the sale, he forgot about Lord Hanuman's prasadam. After reaching home, he told his wife about the sale. He ate and slept but was only thinking of the toor dal sale. "How much profit should I take per Kg? If I give a lower quality dal, I can make more profit." He kept thinking and went to sleep. He completely forgot about the prasadam. In the morning after having bath, Shubby setth saw the photo of Lord Hanuman on the wall. He remembered about the prasadam. He looked in the Bullock cart. The prasadam was eaten by ants. There was none left. He felt sorry and went back in the house.

Lord Hanuman was angry that his prasadam was neglected. In any circumstances, any gods prasadam should not be neglected. The prasadam offered to gods has a lot of power. If we take that prasadam we get good health. Any kind of diseases vanish soon. Now since Shubbhi Shetty neglected Lord Hanuman's prasadam, Lord Hanuman was angry with Shubbhi Shetty. The Lord thought due to his greed for money he neglected my prasadam. I have to teach Shubbhi shetty a lesson for doing so much paapam. After 4 days Shubbhi Shetty gave 100 kgs of Toor Dal in bags to a clerk and send them to Ramapuram in a bullock cart. After the bullock cart left the village and went some distance a big group of monkeys came and jumped in the cart. The driver felt afraid and got down and stood on a side. The monkeys attacked the clerk so he got down too. Then the monkeys tore the toor dal bags and threw the dal everywhere. Shubbhi Shetty felt very bad hearing what happened. He thought I lost so much money. Then Shubbhi Shetty's businesses ran into a loss, he got a disease and was bed ridden. Then he died.

Due to the bad karma of neglecting the prasadam of Lord Hanuman he was born as a donkey and carried weights for his owner. The owner would make him carry weights even when his back was wounded. After undergoing many hardships he died and was born as a rat. Any bad thing done towards God hurts you for several lives. It does not leave you. Those who Lord Hanuman is angry on get a lot more punishment. Shubbhi Shetty who was born as a rat, kept running around in godowns and finally was killed and eaten by a cat. Then He was born as a sparrow. The sparrow kept flying here and there and finally reached Dharmapuram Hanuman Temple. 


