

Few important things about the vratham

- Any body can perform this vratham anytime, there is no restriction of age, gender or caste to perform it.
 There is no need to fast on the day of the vratham. It is very good to read these stories Pournami or
 Ekadhashi or on the day of the Arudhra star, it is even more auspicious. It is good to read this book on
 Mondays. If one reads these stories on a Monday of the Karthika month, bad karma accumulated for
 several births will vanish. One will get lots of punya (good merit). No need to fast on the day of the
 vratham.
- Before performing this vratham, do pray to Lord Ganesha in your mind then pray to the navagrahas. Then
 say your name, your family members names and your gothram and then start the vratham. Then chant the
 108 names of Goddess Parvathi and Lord Shiva. Then perform Adhanga puja of Lord Shiva. Then read
 the 5 of this vratham.
- If you do this vratham before competitive exams you will get great success in those exams. Even before going to interviews if you do this vratham you will get great success in the interview.
- There is no rule that the couple should do this vratham together. The husband and wife can do the vrath according to their convenience and sometimes when possible they can do it together too.
- Unfortunately if a person lost his/her spouse they can do this vratham. They will get mental piece as a
 result of the vratham.
- Every Monday if one reads the 5 stories of this vratham and offers bananas or guavas to Lord Shiva and then takes prasadam any kind of diseases will immediately vanish. There will be no misfortunes or untimely deaths, Those who cannot read can listen to the stories from their relatives and there will be a lot of benefit.
- If the priest reads these stories every Monday in the temple, the temple will become very powerful and famous, all the devotees coming there will get Lord Shivas grace.
- If one performs this vratham in one of the Jyorthirlinga (12 famous Lord Shivas temples), the bad karmas from several births will vanish. Their bodies will get a new glow and they will live happily.
- Those people who don't have kids, if they read the ashtotram and stories in a temple for three continuous days, once each day (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday) they will get good kids. Similarly a girl or boy who is unmarried and seeking to get married, reads the ashtotram and stories in a temple for 3 days beginning on a Monday, they will get a good spouse soon.
- If your kids living far away cannot read, you can read for them to have kids, get married or get a good job. There will be good results.
- When possible it gives good results to call the priest and get this vratham done keeping a Kalasha and praying to Navagrahas and ashtadikpalakas.
- In this way any body can read this book according to their convienience and get good results.

First Story of Shri Maheshwara Vratham

Lord Maheshwara loves his devotees dearly and helps those who seek refuge in him. Each day if you say Om Nama shivaya atleast once, all good prosperous things will happen. There will be no mishaps. There will be no fear of untimely death. Lord Maheshwara himself told this vratham to a great devotee called Vishwapathi RamaKrishna Murthi. Those who do this vratham with a calm mind with devotion towards the Lord Shiva will get all kinds of prosperity.

In olden days in the banks of river Kaveri, there lived a great devotee of Lord Shiva called Shiva sharma. He was learned in all the Shastras and was well-noted in the neighbouring towns and cities as a learnt and knowledgable scholar. He was a scholar of literature and Astrology. He and his wife Sumathi had two daughters. Both daughters got married to very good gentlemen. They always thought this to be due to the blessings of Lord Shiva. Sumathi always helped Shivasharma and was supportive of him.

On every Ekadhashi Shiva Sharma did abhishekam to the lord (11 times reading Namakam and chamakam and offering 11 coconuts), this is called Ekadhasa Rudhra abhishekam. On that day Shiva sharma and Sumathi made sure all the friends and relatives who came to their house were served meals. Every moment Shivasharma and his wife remembered and prayed to the Lord Shiva.

Unfortunately it so happened that shive sharma got an eye disease and he could not see well. He took a lot of medicines but there was no use. The vision kept detoriating as days passed. Because he could not see properly he tripped over something fell and broke his leg. He had to be on bed for 2 months.

The couple Shivasharma and Sumathi felt very unhappy and depressed thinking that although they were devoted to Lord Shiva they got so many troubles. They always prayed to Lord Shiva saying "Parameshwara why all are we having all these troubles"

For anyone, they have to suffer as a result of bad karma from the previous lives. Lord Shiva is very merciful. Since Shivasharmas bad karma was over, Lord Shiva decided to help his bhakta. The next day Lord Shiva came to their house in the form of an old Brahmin. Shiva sharma and Sumathi thought there is divine glow in the old Brahmin. The couple bowed to the Brahmin and said "Swami. You look like a great Tapaswi, Please have mercy on us and tell us a way to get rid of our troubles."

Then Lord Shiva who was in the form of an old Brahmin said "I understand your sorrow! I will tell you a way to get rid of all your troubles. As soon as shiva sharmas hand touched that devotees hand he felt like some electricity went through his body. Holding his hand Shivasharma climbed up the stairs very easily and quickly. As soon as he went on top of the hill he saw the magnificient temple. Shiva sharma and Sumathi went into the temple with closed eyes deeply meditating on the lord and as soon as Shiva sharma opened his eyes his vision was perfect. He had darshan of the lord. 


