


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Few important things about the vratham

- Any body can perform this vratham, anytime, there is no restriction of age, gender or caste to perform it. There is no need to fast on the day of the vratham. It is good to read this book on Thursdays. If one reads these stories on a, bad karma accumulated for several births will vanish. One will get lots of punya (good merit). No need to fast on the day of the vratham.
- Before performing this vratham, do pray to Lord Ganesha in your mind then pray to the navagrahas. Then say your name, your family members names and your gothram and then start the vratham. Then chant the 108 names of Sai Baba. Then perform Adhanga puja of Sai baba. Then read the 5 of this vratham.
- There is no rule that the couple should do this vratham together. The husband and wife can do the vrath according to their convenience and sometimes when possible they can do it together too.
- Unfortunately if a person lost his/her spouse they can do this vratham. They will get mental piece as a result of the vratham.
- Every Thursday if one reads the 5 stories of this vratham and offers bananas or guavas to Sai Baba and then takes prasadam any kind of diseases will immediately vanish. There will be no misfortunes or untimely deaths, Those who cannot read can listen to the stories from their relatives and there will be a lot of benefit.
- If the priest reads these stories every Thursday in the temple, the temple will become very powerful and famous, all the devotees coming there will get Sai Baba's grace.
- If one performs this vratham in Shirdi or any other holy place, the bad karmas from several births will vanish. All diseases in the body will vanish, their bodies will get a new glow and they will live happily.
- Those people who don't have kids, if they read the ashtotram and stories in a Sai temple on Thursday they will get good kids. Similarly a girl or boy who is unmarried and seeking to get married, reads the ashtotram and stories in a temple on a Thursday, they will get a good spouse soon.
- If your kids living far away cannot read, you can read for them to have kids, get married or get a good job. There will be good results.
- When possible it gives good results to call the priest and get this vratham done keeping a Kalasha and praying to Navagrahas and ashtadikpalakas.
- In this way any body can read this book according to their convenience and get good results.

Another important thing is that Sai Baba loves his devotees a lot. He looks after his devotees like his own children. He always takes care and protects his devotees. If you do the vratham with a peaceful mind, said Baba will come to your house and take the prasadam himself. He may come in the form of a relative or a stranger, he may even come as a dog, cat or bird. Saibaba himself said this.

In olden days 40 miles away from Ahmednagar there was a small village. There lived a cobbler called Vishwanatha Rao in that village. He used to live in a small hut and would earn his living by repairing shoes under a small current pole in the center of the village. He had a wife and two daughters. It was very difficult for him to maintain his household with the income he got. Some days he had income from repairing shoes and on other days there would be no income.

Vishwanadha Rao was a great devotee of Sai Baba. He always remembered Sai Baba and chanted Sai Baba's name while doing his work. He always believed that some time, Sai Baba will help him out of his difficulties. Every morning, he would pray to the small Sai Baba photo in his house. At 10 am every day when he went to work under the current pole, he would take the photo with him. He would hang the photo on the current pole, sit under it and begin his work. He would bring his repair tools in a small bag. At 6 in the evening he would pack all his repair tools in the bag. He would also remove the Sai Baba photo from the current pole and he would carry the bag and the photo and walk back home.

Every day while going back home, he would buy the vegetables and other items needed at home from the money he got. He would never ask customers to give more money, he would take what they gave. One day while he was working, he heard a government announcement. They said that they would construct and give free houses to low income people. Those who want to get the houses should register their names and addresses at the Revenue office on the 1st of next month. He felt hopeful that with Sai Babas grace if he can get a small house it would be so great. Immediately he heard another announcement, that said, while giving the name, they should pay a fees of 300 Rs. He felt very worried after hearing this. After a lot of hard work, he got only 2 rupees a day, 60 rupees a month, how could he earn 300 rupees. He felt sad about it.

He came home and told the whole thing to his wife in the evening. His wife said, we believed Sai Baba and he will take care of everything. There was only 20 days left to pay 300 rs. He felt it would be very tough to earn 300 in 20 days. He believed Sai Baba was his only saviour.

It was the 1st of the month, the last day to register his name. He only had 210 Rs. He took those and went to the Revenue office. He found a clerk and requested him that he has only 210Rs. He will pay it now and pay the remaining later. The clerk said that we will register the names of only those who pay the whole 300 Rs today. Vishwanatha felt very hopeless hearing this. He did not know what to do and kept going hear and there in that office. He felt that all his hopes will be ruined in a few hours now. Remembering Shri Sai Baba, he talked to a few people coming that side and asked them if we could pay in installments. They said that is not possible. Vishwanatha Rao did not know what to do, he went to the opposite tea stall and drank tea for 10 paise. He remembered Sai saying "Swami don't I have the fortune of having my own house" He decided to go inside meet the officer and tell him his problem. He went inside, saluted the officer and was about to introduce himself saying my name is vishwanatha rao and I am a cobbler. The officer said "Wait, Your father just came and paid 300 rupees for you and went. You will be granted a house soon" He was surprised and was about to say something, when the clerk came in and said "Go now Sir has a lot of work, Sir told you that your old father came and paid the money"

Vishwanadha Rao understood what happened, there were no limits to his joy. He understood that Sai Baba came and paid his registration fees. He went home and told his wife what happened. The whole family was extremely happy. He alway remembered how his Sai Baba helped him. In a few days the government granted him an house. On an auspicious day, they moved into the house and then lived there happily, praying to Sai Baba.

Those who trust Sai Baba do not lack anything. Sai Baba always protects those who remember him constantly. Those who are devoted to Sai and live a righteous life do not face any misfortunes, they have a happy life.
