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Few important things about the Shri Durga vratham

- Any body can perform this vratham anytime, there is no restriction of age, gender or caste to perform it. There is no need to fast on the day of the vratham.
- ❖ This vratham can be performed on Friday of any month. Especially in the month of Magha, Shravana, Ashwija Karthika, Margasira months on any Friday it gives better results. On Fridays which coincide with Pournami, Ekadashi or Dashimi the results are better. In the Dasara Navarathri, on any day if you do perform the vratham it gives a lot of good results. If anyone performs this vratham on every day of the navarathri festival they get the results equal to a 1000 ashwamedha yaghams. The ladies who perform this vratham will be deergha sumangalis, their husband will have a long life. The girls who do this vratham their marriage will be fixed immediately and they will get a very good husband. If someone does this vratham, for children, they get children with very good qualities. If anyone suffering from health issues does this vratham, their diseases will vanish and they will be blessed with great health. In any house if one of the husband or wife does this vratham every Friday that house will have a lot of wealth and prosperity and there will be no lack of anything.
- ❖ Before performing this vratham, do pray to Lord Ganesha in your mind then pray to the navagrahas. Then say your name, your family members' names and your gothram and then start the vratham. Then chant the 108 names of Goddess Durga. Then read the 5 stories and then do offer a fruit to the Goddess Durga as naivaidya.
- On the day of the vratham get up early before Sunrise and have bath and sit at your puja room and keep a photo of Goddess Durga, in front of you. If the space in the puja room is small keep the photo in another place after cleaning the place well. Sitting facing the east side. If this vratham is done in a Durga temple it gives a lot of benefit. Men or women can do this vratham either at home or in the temple. It can be done in a big group too.
- While performing the vratham for naivaidya you can offer any of the following; milk, honey, fruits, vadas, pulihora, payasam (made of rice and jaggery). If you do the vratham on Friday, it is good to offer payasam and pulihora (yellow tamarind rice)
- ❖ If a student writing exams reads the 5 stories and offers bananas to the goddess as naivaidya he/she will get very good results in the exams.
- ❖ If the 5 stories are read in a Shankar math and the Sharada Devi there is offered as naivaidya bananas, great results will be obtained. All work will be completed successfully. Those looking to get married will get married soon, those wanting children will beget children soon. If students or their parents read the stories in a Shankar math the students will get good results in exams.
- ❖ This vratham can be done in the morning or evening without having to fast.
- There is no rule that husband and wife should do this vratham together, each one can do it according to their convenience. When possible they can do it together.
- If you read this book in any temple for the sake of good results in exam, good education, job, marriage or children you will get results faster.
- ❖ The parents can read this book in a temple for the sake of their children when they want their children to achieve good results, get married, have kids or get job or promotion.

In this way any where and any time you read this book with devotion, you will get the blessings of Shri Durga Matha.

First Story of Shubha Durga vratham

In olden days there was a village called Shrikakulum. In that village, there lived a poor Brahmin called Ramachari. He used to work as a purohit and they used to make do with the little income he got. His wife Komalambha was very supportive of him and ran the household very carefully. Komalambha was very softspoken and good natured. After several years of marriage Komalambha gave birth to twins. Both were girls, they named them Lalitha and Pranitha. They brought up the girls very lovingly.

Once there was a sever drought in the village for two years continuously. The farmers could not produce and grain. Hence the villagers did not even have food and were suffering badly. Due to these conditions nobody conducted any vrathas or poojas. So Ramachari did not get any money. All the grain in the house was over, in another two days they would not have anything to eat. Also the girls turned 18 and were of marriageable age. Due to the financial condition Ramachari and his wife did not think about their marriages till now. Komalambha always prayed to Goddess Durga to save her family and remove their difficulties.

One night Komalambha was very worried and prayed to Durga matha a lot. She was not being able to sleep at all thinking about her family's situation and kept praying. Sometime at midnight she fell a sleep and had a dream.

In the dream she was going to the lake at the end of the village. She was very sad and anxious and walking fast in order to commit suicide by jumping in the lake. She thought that was the only resort she had. Suddenly a bright light shone in front of her. In the light stood a beautiful lady adorned with several gold and diamond ornaments. Unconsciously itself Komalambha saluted her with folded hands.

The goddess said "Komalambha all your difficulties will come to an end today. I will tell you a very auspicious vratham. It is **shubha durga vratham.** I am Shubha Durga and I like this vratham a lot. It is a very simple vratham. If you do this vratham all your difficulties will be removed and many auspicious things will happen in your house. Tomorrow is Friday do the vratham tomorrow.

Komalambha saluted the goddess and said thank you for your grace Jaganmatha asked her to describe the procedure of the vratham. The vratham is very easy and dear to me. Those who perform it live very happily and lack nothing. Their life is very fruitful and happy. Men or women can do this vratham. On any Friday get up before the sun rise, have bath, wear clean clothes and do this vratham. Read the 108 names of mine (durga ashtotram given in this book) then read the 5 stories. Make payasam with rice and jaggery and offer it as naivaidyam to me. You can do it in your prayer room or any other place. You can do it alone or by inviting family and friends, you can also do it in a temple. Keep the photo of one of my forms like KanakaDurga, Vijay Durga or Shailapuri and do the prayer read the names and stories. Oh Komalambha tomorrow is Friday. Do this vratham tomorrow all your difficulties will vanish.

In the early morning Komalambha told the dream to her husband. He felt happy, then she got up had bath and did the vratham with lot of devotion. She made payasam and offered it to the goddess. She invited her friend living next door and gave her the prasadam, gave her lunch and also gave tambulum (paan leaves and fruit)

Due to Goddesses Durgas grace a miracle happened that evening itself. A landlord wanted to build a big temple in that village. For that he chose Ramachari to manage the construction. He sent a message to come and begin the work next day. He also gave Ramachari a big salary. Soon the families troubles vanished they found very suitable boys and got Lalitha and Pranitha married. The weddings took place in a grand manner. Ramacharis family always performed Shubha Durga vratham every month on a Friday convenient to them and lived happily ever after.

Sridevi wanted to do the vratham the very next day. She did also think of doing the vratham every day for a month. So she did the vratham beginning the next day for a full month. She did it with great devotion. On the last day of the vratham which was a Friday as soon as Naivaidyam was done, she heard an elderly couple calling at the door.

She opened the door, they said that they were going to the next village and came to have lunch. She offered them lunch and the prasadam. They blessed Sridevi. They gave her a small packet and said open it only after we leave. So Sridevi opened it after they left. She found it filled with gold coins. Not only that it also had a very small shiva linga and a small idol of Goddess Durga. Sridevi realized that Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvathi came to her house and blessed her in the form of the elderly couple. She was extremely happy. Due

to the Goddesses blessings the landlord Ramaya recovered within an year. He earned a lot of wealth and they got all their businesses and properties back. In fact they were more wealthy then before. Similarly if you do on a Friday that coincides with Ekadashi, Dhasimi or Pournami, the benefit will be more. If anyone performs this vratham on every day of the navarathri festival they get the results equal to a 1000 ashwamedha yaghams. The ladies who perform this vratham will be deergha sumangalis, their husband will have a long life. The girls who do this vratham their marriage will be fixed immediately and they will get a very good husband. If someone does this vratham, for children, they get

children with very good qualities. If anyone suffering from health issues does this vratham, their diseases will vanish and they will be blessed with great health. In any house if one of the husband or wife does this vratham every Friday that house will have a lot of wealth and prosperity. There will be no lack of anything.

This great vratham is an easy way to help us get out of difficulties in this Kali Yuga. Those who listen to the stories or take the prasadam, will get the goddesses blessings too.
